Everything you need when traveling with your rabbit

Carrier & Transport

- ☐ Travel carrier (properly ventilated)
- ☐ Carrier secured with seatbelt
- ☐ Familiar-smelling towel inside
- ☐ Car charger for phone

Food & Water

- ☐ Enough hay for trip + 1 extra day
- ☐ Pellets (if used)
- ☐ Portable water bowl
- ☐ Fresh vegetables
- ☐ Treats

Litter & Cleaning

- ☐ Portable litter box
- ☐ Litter supply
- ☐ Paper towels
- ☐ Pet-safe wipes
- ☐ Poop bags
- ☐ Vinegar spray (cleaning)

Health & Safety

- ☐ Vet contact info
- ☐ Rabbit health records
- ☐ Emergency vet number
- ☐ Medication (if needed)
- ☐ First aid kit
- ☐ Carrier emergency info

Comfort & Enrichment

- ☐ Favorite toys
- ☐ Hide house or tunnel
- ☐ Familiar blanket
- ☐ Cool pack (for hot weather)

Pre-Trip Checklist

- ☐ Book pet-friendly hotel
- ☐ Research emergency vets at destination
- ☐ Keep car cool/warm
- ☐ Plan rest stops every 2 hours
- ☐ Avoid feeding in moving vehicle

Travel Tips

Rabbits are sensitive to temperature changes. Keep the car between 60-75°F and never leave your rabbit in a parked car. Plan ahead and make sure your destination is rabbit-safe before you go!
